PARENTS' CONSULTATION EVENING – TUESDAY 1ST MARCH 2016 4.30PM – 7.30 PM

On behalf of the teaching team, we would like to invite you and your son/daughter to the Parents' Consultation Evening on Tuesday 1st March 2016 between 4.30pm and 7.30pm.

This is a particularly important opportunity for you to meet formally with individual subject teachers who will be able to provide you with up-to-date information on your youngster's progress and offer advice for next steps. It is also an opportunity for you to discover ways in which you, as parents, can provide support and we very much hope that you will be able to attend.

The evening will be held in the Theatre, where you will be able to meet with teachers of main subjects. It is important that your youngster accompanies you so that they are entirely aware of their next steps, and they should bring their planners in order to make notes. Students will be expected to attend in their school uniform.

We have attached an Appointment Booking form (PC1) which should be completed together with your youngster's teachers during weeks commencing 8th February 2016 and 22nd February 2016. The appointments last a maximum of five minutes in order to ensure that every parent and student have opportunities to speak to the relevant teachers during the evening.
