Castle Project Reward Trip - 3 July 2017

I am pleased to let you know that on **Monday 3 July 2017**, Finham Park 2 will be running an educational trip to the City of Chester. This trip is a reward for the outstanding effort on the Castle Project that was completed earlier in the year.

This is an exciting opportunity for pupils to broaden their knowledge of European and Middle Eastern history. Whilst there, students will:

- > Train as a Roman soldier
- Explore the Roman History Museum, taking part in activities and
- Visit the 'Sick to Death' medieval medicine museum
- > Tour the medieval city walls

Students will need to arrive at school earlier than the normal time, as the coach will depart at 8:00am. We will return to school at approximately 7.30pm.

Due to time constraints on the day, it is highly recommended that students bring in a packed lunch. Therefore, the options are:

- a) Students to bring their own packed lunch, snacks and drinks.
- b) Order a packed lunch from our school canteen and have their account debited (funds must be available on their dinner account). Form attached to be completed & returned Extra snacks/drinks not included
- c) Free school meal pupils, please complete the attached form Extra snack/drinks not included

Whilst this is a reward trip, in order to fund it, we ask for a contribution of £18.50 (non-refundable) towards coach fees and museum entry fees; unfortunately, without this the, trip would be unable to run.

If your child is interested in participating in this visit, please return the attached slip with a payment of £18.50 (non-refundable) by cheque or via Parentpay (www.parentpay.co.uk) by Friday 9 June 2017 at the latest to Student Services.

Finham Park 2 is a cashless school and cannot accept any payments in cash. This money is non-refundable.

Occasionally, a surplus may be generated on the direct cost of school trips and any surplus generated on this trip less than £5 per student will be transferred into school funds and used for educational purposes, any surplus greater than £5 per student will be returned to the parents/guardians.

In accordance with the School's Charging and Remission Policy, parents are invited to make a voluntary contribution for £18.50 towards the cost of the visit. However, if sufficient funds are not generated, then it may not be possible for the visit to take place.

A Peach form should have been completed by parent/carer at the start of the academic term. (Please note: students will not be allowed to go on this trip without this being returned/signed).
