Dear Parents/Carers,

Sports Day - 2022

On **Friday 15th July 2022**, our P.E department is excited to announce that we will be hosting this year's Sports Day at the **University of Warwick Athletics Track (CV4 7AL)**. This is a fantastic opportunity for your child to experience an athletics event at an internationally recognized venue. Please read the below information to help prepare your child for a fantastic day.

- (1) **All students (Year 7, 8, 9, 10) are to arrive at Finham Park 2 by 8:35am for an 8:40am start to mentor time.** All students will be registered in their waiting zones: Northgate students = Sports Hall; Eastgate students = Muga; Southgate = courtyard and Westgate students = tennis courts. Ordered packed lunches need to be collected in the refectory at **8:20am**.
- (2) Once students have been registered, they will walk in their Colleges to the venue supervised by school staff. After a great day, they will be **dismissed at the track at 3pm** and students will make their own way home. After the event, there is extremely limited space to park and pick up students at the venue; please avoid this where possible. I advise using Cannon Park Retail Centre as a nearby pickup point.
- (3) If your child normally rides their bike to school, or they choose to for this day, they will be required to: wear their bike helmet (as normal), bring a suitable bike lock, and then walk their bike with all other students as they travel to the venue. They can ride their bike home.
- (4) Students are to **arrive at school in their official Finham Park 2 P.E Kit** (top, shorts/skort, socks and appropriate trainers). Additionally, if students have an appropriate and correctly coloured t-shirt which matches their College colour, they are allowed to wear that instead. For example, an Eastgate student could wear an appropriate red t-shirt because red is the official colour of Eastgate.
- (5) The day itself will be split into two halves. The first will be the formal athletics events being hosted on the track, in the throwing areas and at the jumping zones. The second half will be a range of inter-gate competitions where all students and staff will be participating for additional College points.
- (6) Students must bring with them: a waterproof coat; umbrella; a water bottle; sun hat; sun cream; any medication needed throughout the day. Lunch will be at the venue. Therefore, can your child either bring with them a **packed lunch or order from the attached lunch form**. Free school meal students should also order from the attached form.
- (7) Students will have access to an ice-cream van and charity stalls during the morning activities. Therefore, students are allowed to bring with them a small quantity of cash. I recommend around £5 per student. As always, students will be responsible for their own expensive items (including bikes) and their cash on the day. Rules around mobile phones remain the same as a normal school day.
- (8) If your child is currently injured please email me directly (m.hudson@finhampark2.co.uk) because there will be limited spaces in the school mini-bus for students who cannot walk to the venue. Additionally, at the end of Sports Day, students will be dismissed at the track. If you have concerns about your child being able to walk home, please email me directly because we again have limited spaces on the school mini-bus which will return to school.
- (9) The venue currently offers **limited shade** for students and staff. Please make sure your child has all items on the below check lists to help them have an amazing day.



Sports Day Check List:

- Students to arrive at school in full P.E kit (FP2 socks, FP2 shorts/trousers/skort and FP2 P.E top)	
- Students can wear an appropriately coloured t-shirt or jumper that represents the colour of their college	
- Any medication normally needed	
- A packed lunch OR please complete the attached order form to request a school packed lunch. Please hand in your physical order form to student services or email me with your order (m.hudson@finhampark2.co.uk)	
- Large water bottle	
- Sun hat (can be kept in bag)	
- Sun cream (can be kept in bag)	
- Water proof coat (can be kept in bag)	
- Umbrella to protect them from the sun or rain	
- A small amount of cash (recommendation of around £5)	
- No phones or expensive items are needed at sports day. If students choose to bring these items, they must remain in their bags under their own supervision.	
- Bike helmet and bike lock (if taking a bike)
