UNIFORM CHOICES FOR EXTREME WEATHER

I hope you are well and have been enjoying the wonderful weather we have been experiencing recently.

As you will be aware on Monday and Tuesday next week (18th & 19th July) much of the country will be experiencing extreme temperatures. To help ensure students feel comfortable for learning in school we are *temporarily* adapting the school uniform policy and allowing students a greater choice in what they can wear to school on these days. This letter is to clarify what uniform is appropriate during the extreme weather and when students are expected to be back in 'normal' school uniform.

On **Monday 18th and Tuesday 19th July ONLY**, students will be able to choose to wear:

- Finham Park 2 P.E kit (including trainers)
- Normal school uniform (but they do not need to wear a tie or blazer)

Students cannot wear non-school uniform e.g. flip flops or sandals, hats, sportswear that is not FP2 P.E kit, hoodies or tracksuits instead of a blazer, trainers (if they are wearing normal school uniform). If students choose to wear non-school uniform, they will be sent home to change or asked to wear spare uniform we have in school.

On **Wednesday 20th and Thursday 21st July** students will be expected to be in **normal, full school uniform including ties and blazers**. If necessary, we may decide that students can remove ties again on these days. Students can already remove blazers in classrooms without asking their teacher.

Thank you for your support with ensuring your child(ren) are wearing the most appropriate uniform during the last week of the school year.
